- 1. I am an attorney practicing law in Honolulu, Hawaii and admitted to the Hawaii state and federal courts. I was appointed co-counsel and liaison counsel for the Plaintiff Class in the above-captioned action along with Jon M. Van Dyke who passed away in November 2011.
- 2. I make this Declaration in support of my application for an award of attorneys' fees for services rendered to the Class certified in the above-captioned litigation, and for reimbursement of expenses reasonably incurred in the course of such representation. The time expended in preparing this Declaration and attorney fees and costs is not included.
- 3. Compensation for the services rendered is wholly contingent. Any fees and reimbursement of expenses will be limited to such amounts as may be awarded by this Court. The time for which compensation is sought for Sherry P. Broder includes the time incurred from July 31, 2013 to December 31, 2018. During that period, Sherry P. Broder devoted 292 hours of work. Based upon our hourly rate ordinarily charged to my other clients, the lodestar value of my

time is \$575/hour. Attached hereto is a detailed presentation of the time expended and the

services performed.

5. During this same period, I incurred expenses in the sum of \$1071.15 in

connection with these collection activities.

6. All of the services performed by Sherry P. Broder in connection with this

litigation were reasonably necessary in the prosecution of this case and of the type which would

be charged to an hourly fee paying client.

• 7. There has been no unnecessary duplication of services for which compensation

is now sought.
