Having considered the Motion of Class Counsel for an Order authorizing a second distribution to eligible Class members from the Settlement Fund and it appearing that the Class settlement Fund has sufficient funds to warrant a third distribution to eligible Class members, the Court grants the Motion as follows:

1. Plaintiffs' Lead Counsel shall effect distribution of US\$1,500, or the equivalent in Philippine Pesos, from the Class Settlement Fund maintained by the Clerk of the Court to Class members for each eligible claim.

2. An "eligible claim" is a claim by a Class member who submitted claim forms, as ordered by the Court, in both 1993 and 1999 as memorialized in

the database maintained by Lead Counsel for the Court. It is anticipated that payment will be made on approximately 6,500 eligible claims.

3. On or before April 10, 2019, the Clerk of the Court is directed to wire transfer to Lead Counsel's firm, Kohn, Swift & Graf, P.C., the sum of \$9,750,000 from the Class Settlement Fund for deposit in PNC Bank and/or a national bank in the Philippines for further distribution to eligible claimants, the vast majority of whom reside in the Philippines.

4. On or before April 10, 2019, the Clerk of Court is directed to wire transfer to Lead Counsel's firm, Kohn, Swift & Graf, P.C., \$200,000.00 from the Class Settlement Fund as an advance for the expected costs of distribution.

5. At the conclusion of the distribution, Lead Counsel shall submit to the Court a detailed accounting of the distribution and the costs incurred. Lead Counsel shall return to the Clerk of Court any unexpended monies for re-deposit in the Class Settlement Fund.
