of Class Counsel's Motion to Discontinue
TO: MEMBERS OF THE PLAINTIFF CLASS

You are receiving this Notice because you are a member of the Plaintiff Class in the above case. The case seeks unpaid minimum wages for Class members who worked at Club Onyx in Philadelphia between 2015 and 2018. The central issue in the case is whether you worked as an independent contractor or, as alleged by the five (5) Class representatives, as an employee. Employees, by law, are entitled to payment of a minimum wage for the hours worked. The defendants are The End Zone, Inc. ("TEZ"), the corporation which operated Club Onyx, and its parent company, RCI International Holdings, Inc. ("RCI"). Club Onyx closed in 2018.

After the completion of discovery, including depositions, RCI (but not TEZ) moved for summary judgment contending that it did not exercise control over TEZ's employment practices and therefore should not be held liable. The motion was thoroughly briefed by all counsel. After considering RCI's motion and all the evidence, the Court ruled on December 20, 2024 that the Class's evidence against RCI was insufficient and dismissed RCI as a defendant.

Efforts to settle the litigation through Court mediation failed. The final phase of the case will be a trial against TEZ seeking unpaid minimum wages.

Class Counsel have advised the Court that any ultimate judgment against TEZ will be uncollectible because TEZ has no assets. In light of this, Class Counsel have filed a Motion with the Court to permit the discontinuance of this case. Class Counsel have concluded that the cost and effort of going to trial against TEZ would be wasteful since the Class members would never receive any compensation. Class Counsel have further stated that they have devoted a great deal of time to the litigation over the course of seven (7) years, as well as advancing all costs of the litigation.

The Court has scheduled a hearing on this Motion for Ju/ 30, 2025 at Ja.m. in Courtroom No. in City Hall. At the hearing. Class Counsel will explain their reasons for the Motion. You will have an opportunity to address the Court should you support or oppose the motion. In addition, you may submit a position on the Motion in writing and mailed to Class Counsel no later than July 23. 2025. Class Counsel will forward your submission to the Court. The Court will then decide whether or not to discontinue the case.
